New England Wild Flower Society

The Society, dedicated to all aspects of native plant conservation, has always promoted native plant horticulture as a tool to connect people both physically and emotionally to our natural world. We are not alone, however, and as demand has grown, so have the number of landscape professionals who share this passion for native plants. This publication is a way to connect these professionals with those who need their services.

What Are Native Plants?

Most people define North American native plants as those found here before European settlement. We prefer to use the word “native plant,” not “wildflower,” because some wildflowers are Eurasian plants that have established themselves here in the last 300 years. Plants “native to New England,” or “native to Vermont,” define a more specific group of plants.

Why Landscape With Native Plants?

Many people argue that native plants are better adapted to our climate, but some native plants are as difficult to cultivate as the most challenging non-natives. We do believe, however, that growing native plants develops a sense of regional identity and gives gardeners and landscapers a special connection to the natural world and to wildlife that might be dependent on those plants. Landscaping with native plants is also a personal, albeit small-scale, way to compensate for the increasing development of open space.

The Resource List

The following list of regional native plant landscape professionals is by no means complete. All of those listed encourage the use of native plants, but few use them exclusively. Many offer other services such as landscape installation, plant identification, consulting, or garden maintenance. They may subcontract some of the listed services. We encourage professionals who are not in this year’s list to contact us about inclusion in future editions of this publication. Space considerations prevent us from detailing all of the specialties offered by these designers. Many can recommend plants for specific conditions such as shade, seaside, or dry, well-drained sites. Educating clients about the benefits of native flora is a high priority for a number of those listed, and some offer lectures and slide shows.

In the following section, we suggest questions a potential client should ask when considering any landscaper or designer.*

Choosing a Landscape Design Professional

This publication lists basic services and specialties for each landscape professional. When selecting a consultant, it is important to know much more about the person you will hire. The following suggested questions are not definitive, as each project is different, but may serve as a place to start.

- May I see your resume?
- Can you provide references?
- How long have you been in business?
- What types of services do you offer, and what are your specialties?
- Where can I see examples of your completed projects?
- What is your rate?
- Do you charge for estimates?
- Do you charge by the hour or by the project?
- Do you charge for travel time?
- May I see proof of insurance against accidents and other liability?

It is also important to discuss what you want in your landscape. Do you prefer only plants native to New England, native to North America, or a mix of natives and non-natives? Another topic for discussion is availability of plants—some plants are only available from nurseries in the spring. A written contract detailing all services, charges, and expected outcomes is your best guarantee of a successful collaboration.

Sources of Native Plants

We encourage you to purchase only nursery-propagated native plants. “Nursery-propagated” means the plants have been grown from seed, cutting, or division for the sole purpose of resale. We support nurseries that sell only these plants and that never purchase for resale commercially harvested, wild-collected plants. Commercial wild collection, especially when it involves rare or sensitive species, can have a serious impact on plant populations. “Nursery-grown” can mean wild-collected plants grown for a year in the nursery before being offered to the public. New England Wild Flower Society operates the largest retail native plant nursery in New England, with locations at Garden in the Woods in Framingham, Massachusetts, and Nasami Farm in Whately, Massachusetts. When you purchase our nursery-propagated native plants, you are directly supporting our plant conservation mission, helping to protect our natural heritage for generations to come. Please buy locally, and continue to ask local nurseries to offer native plants.

Founded in 1900, New England Wild Flower Society is the nation’s oldest institution dedicated to the conservation of wild plants. The Society’s mission is to promote the conservation of temperate North American plants through education, research, horticulture, habitat preservation, and advocacy. The Society’s botanical garden and living museum, Garden in the Woods, displays the largest landscaped collection of native plants in the Northeast.
